












Safety Precautions

Be sure to observe the following precautions.

If the product is so modified that the product specification is changed, we may not be responsible for the product quality assurance. 	 Be sure to observe.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Check that the cabinet to be installed is securely fixed to the wall or equivalent. If not the product may tip over when being rotated, and may cause personal injury and damage.
 Be sure to observe.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Use the designated screws. If not, the product may turn over, and accordingly injure you. 		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● For proper cabinet installation the wall or equivalent must be a thickness of 15 mm or more for sufficient strength. If you use materials with less strength, such as those of flush structure (hollow structure) or MDF materials, the product may turn over, and cause damage and personal injury.

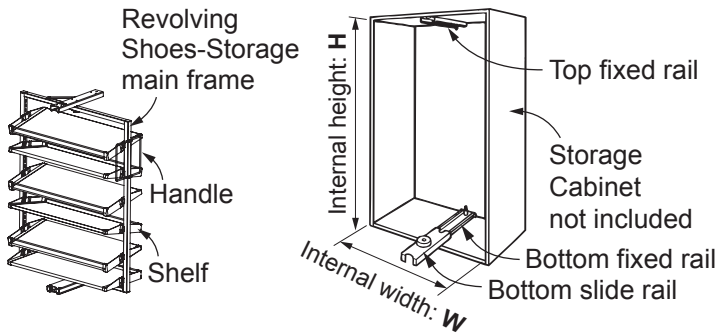

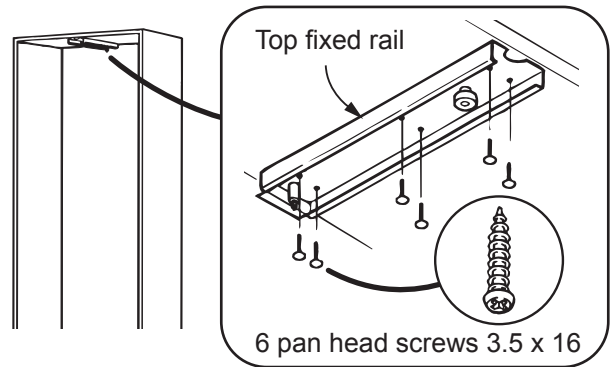

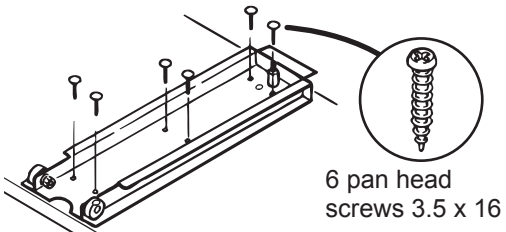


1 Installing top fixed rail



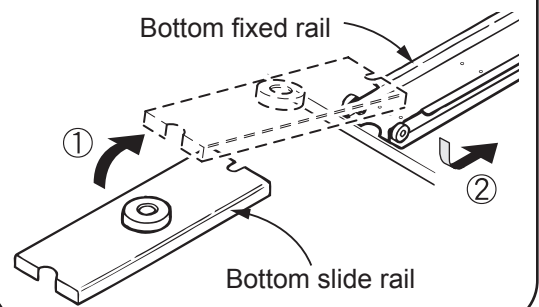
2 Installing bottom fixed rail and bottom slide rail

1. Installing bottom fixed rail



CAUTION Tighten the rail securely with screws.

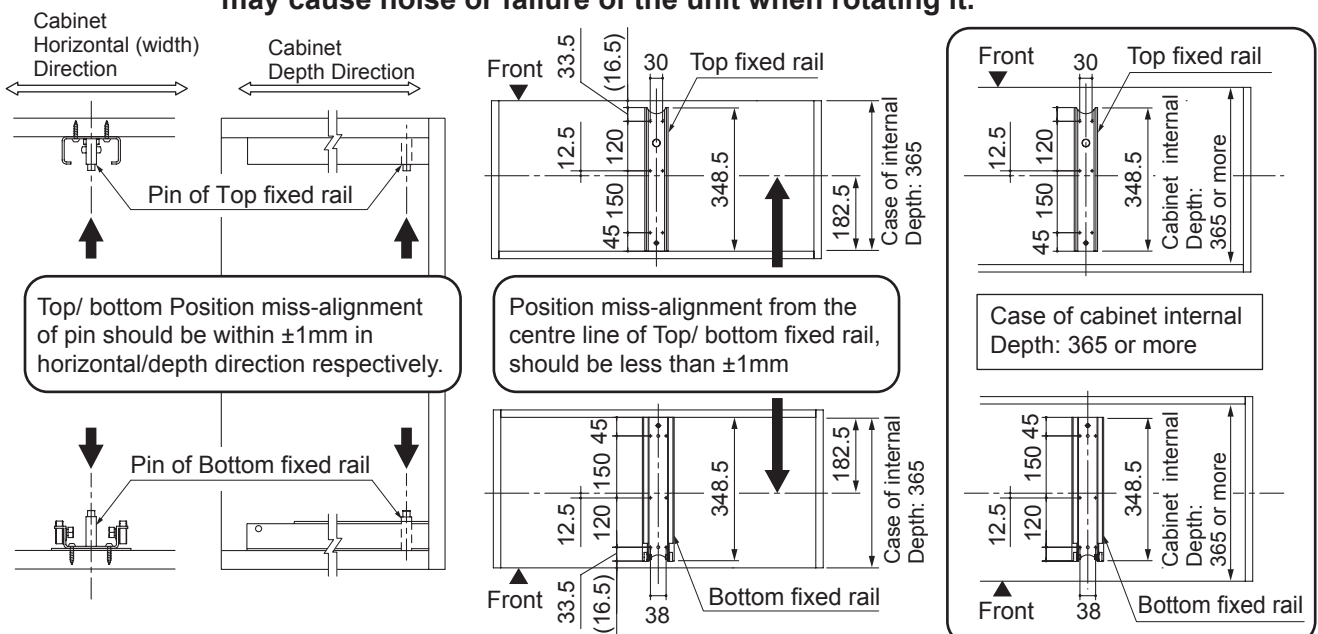
2. Installing bottom slide rail



Top/bottom fixed rail component mounting position

CAUTION

For both top and bottom fixed rails, no notable positional displacement is allowed in the horizontal or vertical direction. A large positional displacement between the top and bottom rails, if any, may cause noise or failure of the unit when rotating it.

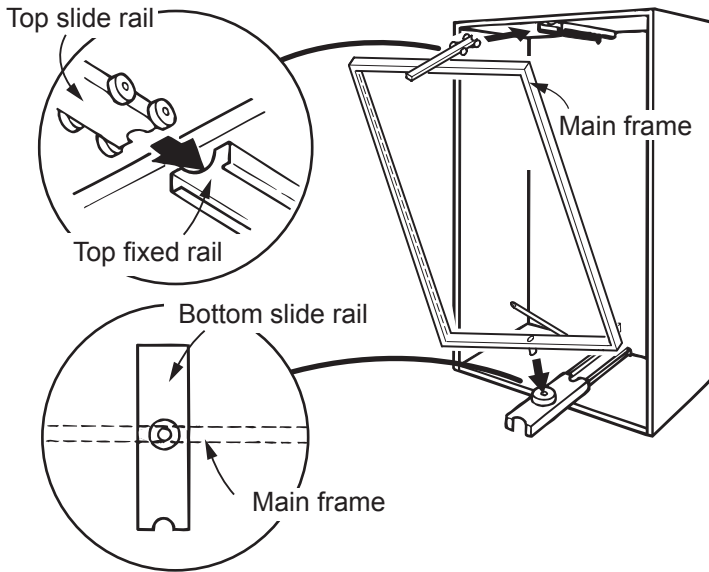


*Make the cabinet inclination in horizontal or vertical direction less than 1mm.

*If the dimension of the internal cabinet depth is greater than 365mm, be sure to install main frame to fit the center position of cabinet.

3 Installing main frame

Mount the upper and lower arm on the top and bottom fixed rails.



Align the main frame to the bottom slide rail groove in the right direction.

CAUTION

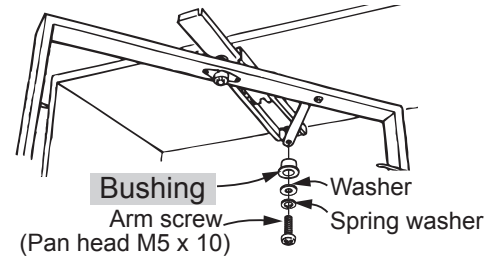


Be sure to observe.

Fix the mounting screws firmly.
(Tightening torque: 15 to 20 kgf·cm)

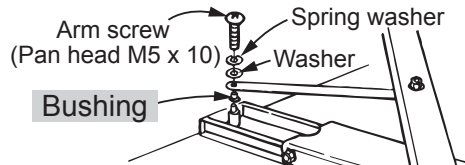
If not, the main frame may fall, and injure you.

Fixing the upper arm



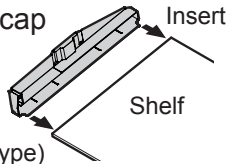
CAUTION Do not mount the bush in the wrong direction.

Fixing the lower arm



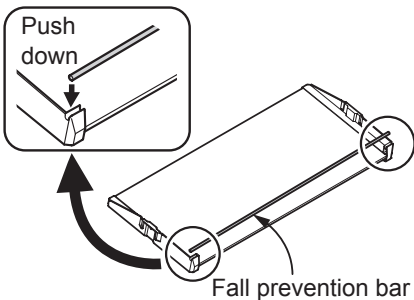
4 Installing Shelves and Fall Prevention Bars

① Shelf side cap



(L type and R type)

② Fall prevention bar



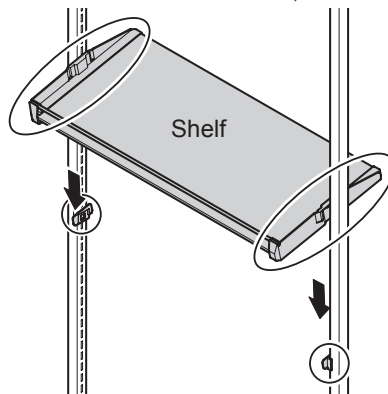
■ Assembling Shelves

- ① Insert both shelf board side caps (L type and R type) into each shelf.
- ② Insert the fall prevention bar into the groove at the front of each shelf side cap, and click into place.

■ Installing Shelves onto Main Frame

- ③ Insert the shelf bracket (L type and R type) into both left and right holes of the main frame.
- ④ Slide the shelf down and engage the shelf brackets with the grooves at both ends of the shelf.

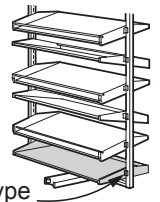
To remove the shelf, do the above operation in the reverse order.



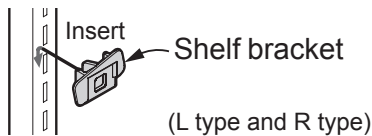
CAUTION

● When installing the shelves, alternate the position of the Fall Prevention Bar (back to front) for each consecutive lower shelf.

● The very bottom shelf is mounted in a fixed horizontal position. Mount this bottom shelf using the H type shelf bracket.

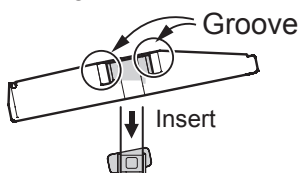


③ Shelf bracket

5 Installing the handle

- Handle mounting screws are pre-mounted on the main frame.
- Remove the screws and position the handle as shown. Reinsert the pre-installed screws.
